

Packing List

Just in case your bags get lost or delayed by the airlines, bring a carry-on bag with everything needed for 2 days.

Luggage:

- Soft sided Bag...No suitcases
- Beach bag or backpack
- Under-the-shirt security pouch for documents
- Dry bags for money, phone, passport, etc.
- Laundry bag
- Small cross body purse

Documents:

- Passport + copy and picture on your phone
- Driver's License + copy and picture on your phone
- Travel Health Visa & COVID-19 documents
- Credit cards- Be sure to let them know you will be abroad
- Health Insurance Card

Clothes:

- 3 pajamas
- 3-5 pair of socks
- 5-7 pair underwear
- 2 bras (1 sports bra)
- 3-5 assorted tops (1 long sleeve for layering)
- 2-3 pair casual pants, shorts, capris, or skirts
- 2 sundresses
- 1 nicer outfit/ blazer and shoes for going out
- 1 pair of walking shoes
- 1 pair of flip-flops
- 1 pair water shoes
- 1-2 fitness outfits
- 1 sweater or sweatshirt
- 3-6 swimsuits and cover ups
- 1 Swim shirt/ rash guard
- Windbreaker
- Rain jacket or poncho

Health & Hygiene: Consider using reef friendly products.

Shampoo, conditioner, body wash, sunscreen, insect repellent, and hair dryer provided.

- Shampoo, conditioner & body wash (if you prefer to bring your own)
- Facial Cleanser
- Facial moisturizer
- Eye gel
- Body lotion
- Brush/ comb, hairband & ties
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Deodorant
- Shaving cream and razors
- Feminine hygiene products
- Makeup (Tinted sunscreen +BB cream, bronzer, waterproof mascara & lipstick)
- Makeup remover
- Hair products
- Insect repellent (non-aerosol)
- Sunscreen lotion (No oils or aerosols please)
- Face stick sunscreen or zinc
- Aloe gel for sunburn
- Lip balm with SPF
- Nail file, clippers, and tweezers
- Contact lens supplies
- Bonine or other seasickness remedy
- Prescription medication in original container & EpiPen
- Travel Meds: Imodium, ibuprofen, Tums, eye drops, Benadryl, allergy meds, inhaler, anti-itch cream, Band-Aids, Neosporin
- Hand sanitizer/ baby wipes



Electronics:

- E-reader
- Smartphone
- Headphones
- Camera, memory cards, connecting cables
- Portable battery pack
- Laptop computer or tablet (think twice; do you really need it?)
- Bluetooth speaker (to take to the beach)
- Chargers

Accessories:

- Sun Hat with ties
- Sand Free beach towel (to take to the beach)
- Sunglasses with strap
- Prescription glasses or magnifier
- Travel size umbrella
- Goggles & swim cap
- Binoculars
- Small flashlight

Misc:

- Tip money for crew (15%-20% customary)
- One 750ml bottle of alcohol per adult
- Travel journal and pen
- Books or magazines
- Games
- Inflatable float
- Clothes pins
- Personalized flag for fun boat decoration (optional)
- Water Bottle

Do not bring:

- Aerosols
- Oils
- Perfume/Cologne
- Hair dryer
- Jewelry/ valuables
- Illegal drugs
- Firearms

To Do List:

- Schedule Bahamas Entry Covid PCR Test 3 days prior
- Schedule Bahamas Covid Antigen Test for day 5 of trip
- Schedule Departure Covid Test if required
- Apply for Bahamas Travel Health Visa
- Setup Smart Traveler with US Embassy if applicable
- Schedule Transportation To/From Marina
- Make Nail & Wax appointment
- Make Hair appointment

Notes:

- We recommend bringing cash for purchases; local currency as well as USD is widely accepted. Credit cards not always accepted.
- Please inform crew before using hot hair tools so they can run the generator.
- WiFi available on board but speeds vary.
- Cell phone reception is good but contact your provider before arrival.
- North American 110V USA 3-prong power on board.
- No shoes are to be worn on board the yacht please.
